

## Polling Place Buffer Zones for Pasquotank County Polling Places

The following is a list of the Pasquotank County polling places and a description of each buffer zone concerning Election Day electioneering. Buffer zones as designated by G.S.163-166.4(a) and county board of elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of the entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall set the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

Poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with campaign electioneering signs issued by the Board of Elections.

- 1-A Location: Agricultural Extension Bldg., 1209 McPherson Street.  
Electioneering is allowed 30 ft from the entrance of the building in the grassy area between the sidewalk and parking lot. May **not** block pathway!
- 1-B Location: River Road Middle School, 1701 River Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building, by the first light pole next to sidewalk (may **not** block pathway), leading to the front door of the school from parking lot.
- 2-A Location: Knobbs Creek Recreation Center, 200 E. Ward Street  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building, which is next to the round red brick planter to the left of the sidewalk leading into the building. May **not** block pathway!
- 2-B Location: Sheep Harney Elementary School, 200 W. Elizabeth Street  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building which is the sidewalk that runs parallel to the parking lot in front of the school. May **not** block pathway!
- 3-A Location: Central Elementary School, 1059 US Hwy 17 S  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building, to the right or left of the entrance door: On the right side between the light pole and handicap sign; on the left side by the light pole. May **not** block pathway!
- 3-B Location: Pasquotank Elementary School, 1407 Peartree Road  
Electioneering is allowed 35 ft from the entrance of the building, grassy area just before the edge of the curbing at the end of the sidewalk pathway. May **not** block pathway!
- 4-A Location: United House of Prayer for All People, 1317 Southern Avenue  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building in either direction: On the right, the grassy area just past the corner of the building next to parking lot or directly in front of building by the church sign. May **not** block pathway!
- 4-B Location: Kermit E. White Center, 1704 Weeksville Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from entrance of building, which is the second brick planter from the parking lot before entering the brick courtyard. May **not** block pathway!
- MH Location: Evangelical Methodist Church, 820 Okisko Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from entrance of polling location, which is the edge of the sidewalk just past the mulched bed on the left, facing the building. May **not** block pathway!
- NEW Location: Newland Fire Station, 721 US Hwy 158.  
Electioneering is allowed 25 ft from the front entrance of the building, (by flagpole), or 50 ft. from the side of the building, (opposite side of the driveway). May **not** block driveway!
- NIX Location: Towne South Church of Christ, 2224 Peartree Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building, which is halfway between the concrete slab and wooden parking markers.
- PRO Location: Pasquotank County High School, 1064 Northside Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building; back side of the gym next to the parking lot in the grassy area between the corner of the building and the sidewalk. May **not** block pathway!
- SAL Location: Weeksville School, 1170 Salem Church Road  
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the entrance of the building; the grassy area by the light pole or next to the grouping of 3 boxwood bushes and a Crepe Myrtle tree by the sidewalk leading to the entrance of voting enclosure.

## **ONE-STOP VOTING BUFFER ZONE**

Location: Board of Elections office, 426 McArthur Drive

Electioneering is allowed 50 ft. from the entrance of the building. The parking spaces and the drive-through are to be kept clear for vehicles to enter and exit the parking area. The sidewalk is **not** to be blocked! Buffer zone will be strictly enforced!
