The Planning Board and staff recommend that a Special Use Permit be required for event centers in the A-1, Agricultural District along with additional conditions that would mitigate potential impacts on neighboring properties.

 The Board will hold a public hearing on a staff proposed Subdivision Ordinance
 Text Amendment to establish procedures for minor subdivisions, modify family
 subdivision standards, revise street guarantee requirements and require cluster
 mailboxes. These amendments are being proposed in response to recent
 changes in the State Statutes and US Postal Service policies and were
 previously discussed during the Board of Commissioners retreat. The Planning
 Board and staff recommend approval of the amendments as presented.
