A. Appointments to Boards and Committees

At a previous meeting, the Appointments Committee recommended the following appointments to boards and committees:

B. U.S. Motto "In God We Trust" Signage

The Board originally approved displaying the U.S. motto "In God We Trust" on the exterior entrance of the Pasquotank County Courthouse, which would require going through the Historic Preservation Commission's approval process. One option that was not discussed at the October 17, 2022 Board Meeting was placement in the foyer of the Courthouse (pictures attached). This option was discussed with the Buildings and Grounds Committee. The Buildings and Grounds Committee has recommended displaying the motto "In God We Trust" in the foyer of the Courthouse. This display is

consistent with the intended purpose of the sponsors for the proposal (US Motto Committee) and maintains the current building exterior.

C. Repeal of Prohibition of Tattooing Ordinance

At the last meeting, the Board voted 6 to 0 to repeal the ordinance prohibiting tattooing in the County since tattoo parlors are allowed in the C-1 District. The law requires <u>all</u> members vote in favor of an ordinance adoption or repeal at the first meeting it is introduced to be approved. Since the law is not clear how a vacancy affects the vote, the County Attorney is recommending a second vote to avoid any issues. On a second vote, only a simple majority is required even if there is a vacancy, or a Board member is absent.

D. <u>Amendment of Certain County Ordinances with Criminal Penalties to Comply with</u> Session Law 2021-138

As with the "Tattooing Ordinance," at the last meeting the Board voted 6 to 0 to adopt changes to several ordinances which contained a criminal penalty. The law requires <u>all</u> members vote in favor of an ordinance adoption or repeal at the first meeting it is introduced to be approved. Since the law is not clear how a vacancy affects the vote, the County Attorney is recommending a second vote to avoid any issues. On a second vote, only a simple majority is required even if there is a vacancy or a Board member is absent.
