Recommendation is for <u>approval</u> of the proposed Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance and Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMS). This request is consistent with the Pasquotank County Elizabeth City Advanced Core Land Use Plan, <u>Land Use Compatibility Policy 1</u> "Ensure that land use and development activities provide a balance between economic development needs and protection of natural resources and fragile environments" and <u>Natural Hazard Area Policy 4</u> "Ensure that new development is protected from flood hazard through the administration of the County flood damage prevention ordinance and continued participation in the National Flood Insurance Program." The ordinance and maps are reasonable and in the public interest because they are required to ensure that the county remains an active and compliant participant in the National Flood Insurance Program.
