The Pasquotank County Board of Commissioners met today as the Animal Control Board in the Community Room at the W.C. Witherspoon Memorial Library in a continuation of a special meeting that was held on Tuesday, November 13, 2012.

The meeting was reconvened at 3:00 PM.

Motion was made by Gary White, seconded by Joe Winslow that the Board reconvene as the Animal Control Board to continue hearing an appeal by Sabrina Parrish from the Sheriff's Department's determination that her dog, Casper, is a dangerous dog. The motion carried.

Ms. Parrish reported to the Board that Casper has been neutered and she provided proof of the neutering from Dr. Darlene Lannon. She advised that her friend who lives in Chowan County cannot adopt Casper and she needs more time to get him re-homed.


Sheriff Cartwright reported that there have not been any further complaints or issues regarding Casper.

It was noted that Ms. Parrish was given 30 days to have her dog neutered and 60 days to relocate him. Since she has complied with the neuter requirement and the 60 days has not yet expired to re-home Casper, it was suggested that a report be provided to the Board at its meeting on February 4th. It was also suggested that Ms. Parrish inform the Sheriff of any actions in this regard so she will not have to take time from work to appear before the Board again.

Motion was made by Joe Winslow, seconded by Gary White that a report on the possible relocation of Casper be provided to the Board at the February 4th meeting at 7:00 PM. The motion carried 4-0.

The Animal Control Board was recessed at 3:10 PM.
