At the August 17, 2020 meeting, the Board approved the purchase of new voting equipment from Elections System & Software (ES&S). The total cost of the voting equipment was \$100,545, which is under the budgeted amount of \$125,000. The State Board of Elections requires the completion of a simulated election prior to the final approval of voting equipment purchase.

The Elections Office recently completed the required simulated election. As part of those requirements, following the test they have to go back before the Board of Commissioners to present the results and get final approval. Emma Tate, Director of Elections, will present the information and be available for questions. I recommend final approval of the purchase of the new voting equipment for \$100,545.
